PERFORMANCE

- AUM: Keen GP manages over \$100M in two parallel funds: KGC Fund II \$55.3M & KGC Co-Invest Fund II \$45M
- Returns: Combined Net 38.6% IRR. Fund II 15.2% IRR. Co-Invest Fund 52.6% IRR.
- Exits: Keen is expecting a first exit by mid-year 2023 at a valuation that should return majority of all capital.
- GP Commitment: KEEN GPs have invested 12.3% of Fund II and anticipate a material contribution to Fund III.
- Fund III Institutional Sponsor: Keen's Fund II institutional sponsor has invested a total of \$65M between the 2 funds. They have expressed interest to lead Fund III proportional to complimentary fund raising.
